Industrial psychologist Walter Vernon Clarke later refined this theory into a practical assessment tool widely used in professional and personal development.

- Rules, Structure, and Processes

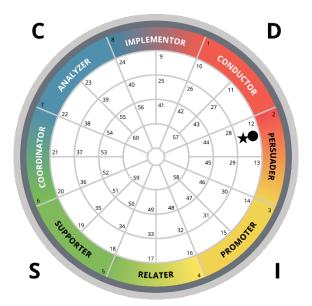
