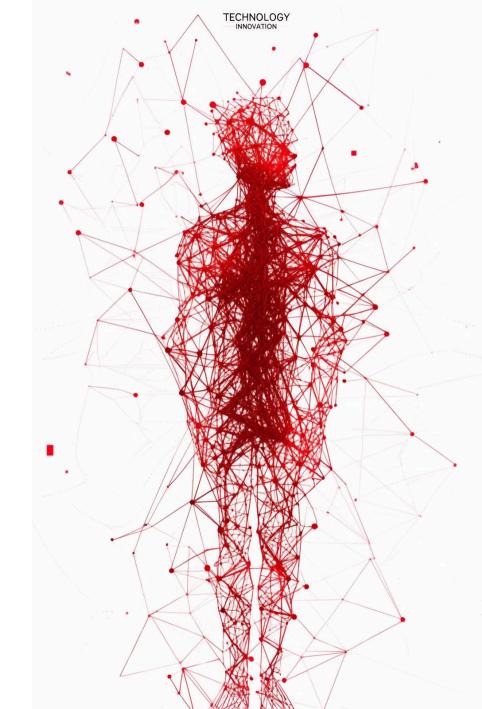

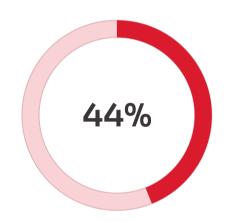

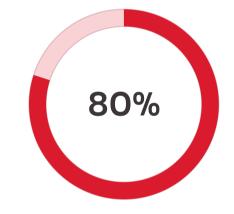
#### Why This Work Is Urgent: What the Research Says

Al is rapidly transforming workplaces, with nearly half of current job tasks facing disruption and the vast majority of organizations adopting generative AI within just a few years.

The World Economic Forum projects that 44% of current job tasks will be disrupted by 2027. Skills like Al literacy, creative thinking, and analytical problem-solving are rising sharply in importance.

Gartner forecasts that by 2026, 80% of organizations will use Generative Al in production. Yet, most senior leaders still use Al as a basic assistant, not a collaborator or strategic thinking partner.



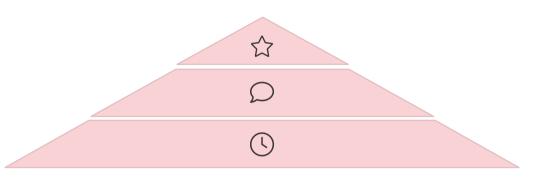
#### The Hidden Competency of Great Leaders

Leaders with superior conversational intelligence outperform their peers. This capability is essential for effective AI collaboration and must be developed urgently.

From our work with over 12,000 leaders, one truth stands out: Conversational Intelligence — the ability to interact effectively with others (and now, with AI) — is the hidden competency separating good leaders from great ones.

If leaders don't learn to communicate vision, ask better questions, clarify outcomes, and shape narrative, AI will remain a low-value tool.

### Core Conversational Intelligence Competencies for the Al Era

Leadership teams who excel in the AI era master four key skills: defining clear outcomes, thinking in multiple steps, exploring diverse perspectives, and transforming raw output into meaningful insights.

#### **Clarity of Vision**

Be able to define outcomes clearly. If you don't know what good looks like, Al certainly won't. Outcomefocused language matters more than ever.

#### **Strategic Curiosity**

Develop multi-step thinking.

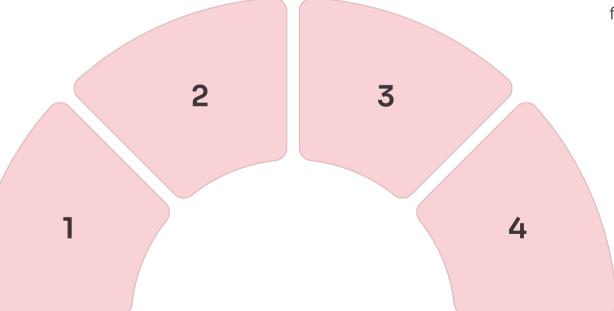

#### **Additional Core Competencies**

Executives and their teams who master decision framing and empathetic communication create more effective Al collaborations and drive better organizational outcomes.

#### **Decision Framing**

Use AI to evaluate trade-offs, weigh options, and clarify risks. Those who frame better decisions lead faster, better-informed organizations.



#### **Empathy and Anticipation**

Ask Al to simulate emotional responses, anticipate confusion, and tailor tone. These prompts result in more trusted communication and buy-in.



#### Real-World Prompt Evolution Examples

Anyone will achieve better results by evolving from generic Al prompts to collaborative prompts that include context, emotion, and intent.



#### **Messaging During Change**

From generic to specific context



#### **Basic Prompt**

"Write an email to motivate my team during change."



#### **Collaborative Prompt**

Incorporates emotional context, culture, and intent

Here are seven practical cases where leaders shifted from generic prompting to transformational collaboration — and what changed as a result.

Messaging During Change Basic Prompt: "Write an email to motivate my team during change."

**Collaborative Prompt:** "Write a 3-paragraph message for my remote finance team. We're adopting new Al-based forecasting software. Some feel overwhelmed and fear being replaced. Tone: supportive, clear, visionary. Highlight upskilling and how their insights guide the Al."

Why It Works: It incorporates emotional context, culture, and intent — essential for trust-building communication.

### The 20-Page Report Problem

It is an imperative to learn to transform vague requests into actionable outcomes by specifying audience, scope, and deliverables. This precision turns theoretical content into practical tools.



#### **Basic Prompt**

"Write a strategic plan for improving customer satisfaction."

#### **Collaborative Prompt**

Narrows scope, audience, and tone

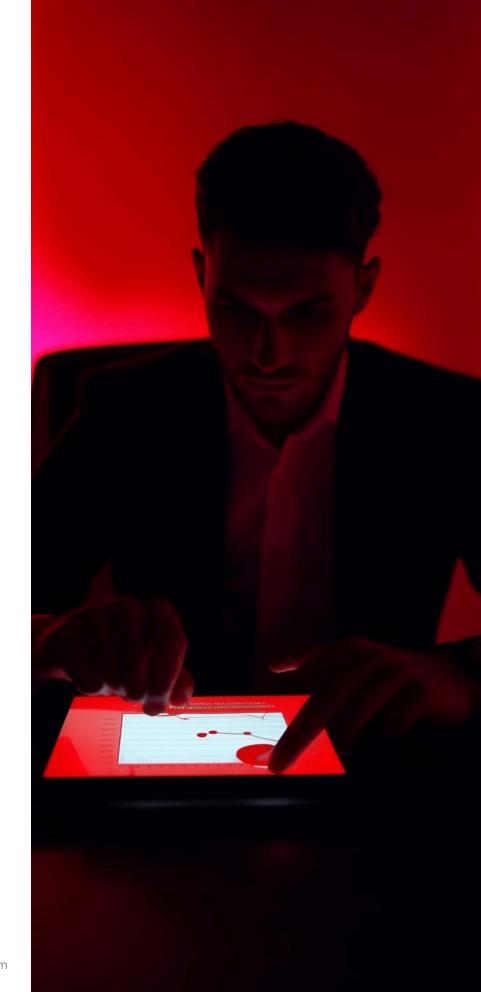

**Basic Prompt:** "Write a strategic plan for improving customer satisfaction."

**Collaborative Prompt:** "Generate a 2-page action brief for a COO of a regional credit union. Prioritize initiatives based on Gallup's 2024 member satisfaction drivers. Emphasize speed of service and empathy in digital experiences. Include KPIs and sample language for internal communication."

**Why It Works:** The leader narrows scope, audience, and tone. The result is usable, not theoretical.





#### Vision Development and Job Role Reframing

Effective AI collaboration requires contextual detail for both vision development and job descriptions. Specificity about business stage, team identity, behavioral traits, and working conditions produces more targeted, actionable outcomes.



#### **Vision Development**

**Basic Prompt:** "Help me write a vision statement for my team."

Collaborative Prompt: "I lead a marketing team in a startup entering Series B. We're evolving from tactical execution to brand leadership. Write a 2-sentence vision that connects creative excellence with measurable business impact. Use inclusive, energizing language."

**Why It Works:** Aligns team identity, stage of growth, and measurable ambition.



#### Job Role Reframing

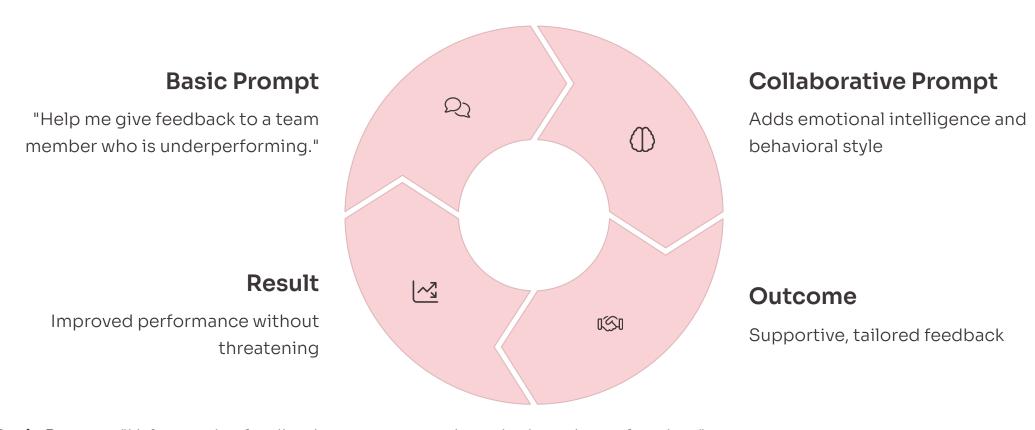
**Basic Prompt:** "Write a job description for a project manager."

Collaborative Prompt: "Design a job description for a cross-functional project lead. We need someone with high DISC-C and Driving Forces of Intellectual and Resourceful. Emphasize coordination of AI-powered tools, coaching team members, and building new workflows. It's hybrid with high autonomy."

**Why It Works:** It blends behavior science, Al tool awareness, and hiring signal specificity.

#### Clarifying Feedback Conversations

Effective feedback requires more than basic requests. By incorporating behavioral styles, emotional intelligence, and personalized approaches, conversations become supportive coaching opportunities rather than threatening evaluations.



Basic Prompt: "Help me give feedback to a team member who is underperforming."

**Collaborative Prompt:** "Draft a coaching script for a high-potential analyst who's missing deadlines. They are C/S on DISC, conflict-avoidant, and intellectually driven. I want to offer support, reaffirm expectations, and help them problem-solve without making them feel threatened."

Why It Works: Adds emotional intelligence and customization based on behavioral style.



#### **Turning Meeting Notes into Action**

Transform standard meeting summaries into actionable briefs by specifying responsibilities, dependencies, and follow-up items, increasing team operational effectiveness.



Basic Prompt: "Summarize this meeting."

**Collaborative Prompt:** "Turn these meeting notes into a 1-page action brief for my team. Clarify who's responsible for each action. Highlight dependencies. Add questions where follow-up is needed and format for use in Notion."

Why It Works: It moves from "nice to know" to "what now?" — the hallmark of operational effectiveness.

### Building a Campaign Using AI as a Team Member

Effective AI collaboration requires moving from basic requests to detailed briefs that specify audience, content strategy, and business goals. The right prompts transform AI from a simple tool to a strategic creative partner.

#### Final Thoughts for Leaders

#### I. Core Al Concepts

- **Al (Artificial Intelligence):** Technology designed to perform tasks that typically require human intelligence, such as reasoning, learning, and language processing.
- **Generative Al:** A type of Al that creates new content—text, images, code, or video—based on patterns in data (e.g., ChatGPT, Claude, Gemini).
- Large Language Model (LLM): A machine learning model trained on massive amounts of text data that can understand and generate human-like language.
- **Multimodal Al:** Al systems that can process and combine different types of inputs like text, images, audio, and video to generate outputs (e.g., Gemini 1.5, GPT-40).
- Narrow Al vs. General Al: Narrow Al excels at a specific task (like drafting emails), while General Al would perform any intellectual task a human can—something we haven't achieved yet.

#### II. Tools & Platforms

- **ChatGPT:** A conversational AI tool by OpenAI. Can summarize, ideate, and simulate dialogue. The Team version includes enterprise-level data controls.
- **Claude:** An Al assistant by Anthropic, known for strong ethics and handling complex documents with long context windows.
- **CoPilot:** Microsoft's Al assistant built into Word, Excel, Teams, and Outlook to support tasks like summarizing, rewriting, or creating visualizations.
- Deep Research Mode (ChatGPT, Gemini, Perplexity): An Al function that deeply analyzes a topic using multiple steps,
  often summarizing and citing sources.
- **Gamma:** A tool that turns rough ideas into beautiful presentations, pages, or documents using AI formatting and design suggestions.
- **Gemini:** Google's suite of AI tools, integrated into Google Workspace. Offers document summarization, image generation, and more.
- **HeyGen:** A tool that creates talking avatars and digital twins for video presenters using voice or a generated voice.
- **Monti:** Cortex's proprietary Al-enhanced texting and behavior-tracking system used in leadership coaching and habit reinforcement.
- **NotebookLM:** A Google tool that lets you upload documents, then interact with them like a chatbot to extract insights, create quizzes, and generate outlines.
- OpusClip: Converts long videos into short, social-ready clips using AI to find highlights and add captions.
- **Perplexity:** A powerful AI search assistant that combines search engine functionality with conversational responses and cited sources.
- **Zoom Al Companion:** A feature that summarizes meetings, creates action plans, and helps with messaging post-call.

#### III. Techniques & Behaviors

- **Conversational Intelligence (CI):** The ability to have effective, trust-building conversations. In the AI context, this includes asking strategic, layered questions to refine AI output.
- Follow-up Prompting: The method of refining your original question or prompt to improve relevance, accuracy, and
  personalization of the Al's output.
- **Reverse Prompt Engineering:** Studying an output you admire (like a graphic, post, or report) and working backward to guess the prompt that may have produced it—then replicating and modifying it.
- **System Prompt:** A "pre-prompt" or instruction that sets the personality or goals of an AI agent (e.g., "Act as a project manager" or "You are a leadership coach").
- **Temperature:** A setting in tools like ChatGPT that controls creativity. Lower values (e.g., 0.2) make the AI more factual; higher values (e.g., 0.8) make it more creative.
- **Vibe Coding:** A term that describes designing systems, workflows, or interactions using plain language rather than traditional programming. Leaders can now create automations and outcomes by "telling" tools what they want in natural language, allowing for high-impact problem-solving without technical barriers.
